

# **June is National Pollinator Month**



Kentucky's Touchstone Energy Cooperatives are doing their part to protect our state's natural treasures during national pollinator month (and every month).

They planted 100 acres of pollinator-friendly nectar plants and maintain eight Monarch butterfly waystations at cooperative-owned facilities, near Cooperative Solar Farm One.

Co-ops have a long history of leadership in environmental stewardship, including partnering with the Kentucky Energy and Environment Cabinet through the KY EXCEL program.

Kentucky Excellence In Environmental Leadership, or KY EXCEL, is a way for the Cabinet to recognize the work done by organizations to promote environmental stewardship. East Kentucky Power Cooperatives, one of Kentucky's Touchstone Energy Cooperatives, has been a KY EXCEL Partner since 2009, which has required performing annual stewardship projects and providing documentation to the Cabinet.

In 2016, a 1.7-acre area was established to feature native wildflowers along with milkweed to provide food for Monarch butterflies. In 2018, another pollinator area was added.


Plus, there are hives of honeybees near the pollinator patch. The hives feature nearly 25,000 honeybees, which visit the flowers in the patch frequently to gather pollen and nectar as food for the hive.

These KY EXCEL projects were a perfect opportunity to not only establish and provide a food source for declining honeybee populations, but also create much needed habitat for the Monarch butterfly, which is being considered for the endangered species list by the U.S. Fish and Wildlife Service.
